To be a State Officer, you must be a member of a local society in the Washington State Society, C.A.R. with your National and State dues paid by January 1, 2021, and be born after April 18, 2000. Election will be held at the annual state conference on March 20, 2021. The Nominating Committee may nominate more than one candidate for each office, and nominations from the floor are permitted, so there may be contested elections. The term of office is one year and begins on the Sunday of the National Convention, April 18, 2021.

BYLAW Article VI, Section 1:

All State Officers are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful, honorable, considerate and conscientious manner at all times. The State Officers, as the leaders of the State Society, are the role models from which the younger members learn. A State Officer must be a positive example for all members to admire and emulate. All State Officers shall perform the duties appropriate to the office, assisted by the respective Senior State Officer and read the joint report, approved by the respective Senior State Officer, at the annual State Conference. Other duties may be assigned by the State President, Senior State President and the respective Senior State Officer.

State President

The State President works with the advice and assistance of the Senior State President. Specific duties of the State President are to represent the Washington State C.A.R. at the National Convention in Washington DC in April, the Western Regional meeting in Nevada (for 2021), in June, and at various C.A.R., DAR and SAR events such as the DAR State Conference and the SAR State Conference). The State President should have the maturity to be able to stand before large groups and least read from prepared remarks.

The State President promotes an annual project. See the WaStateCAR.org website for details on the current project.

The State President has the opportunity to be installed at Mt. Vernon Virginia, near the tombs of George and Martha Washington in conjunction with the C.A.R. National Convention April 16-18, 2021. The Washington State C.A.R. Sampson Fund provides a \$750 stipend to assist with the State President attending the National Convention to be installed. These funds are usually sufficient to cover airfare, hotel, and convention meals and registration for the State President, but not for any companion or chaperone who may also be attending.

A person who has been State President is not eligible to hold that office again.
